Other rules apply and are detailed in our Membership rule Book and are in place to protect the local environment including some restrictions on overnight fishing. We pride ourselves on keeping our waters environmentally friendly, clean and a place for nature to live happily alongside the angler.

We have an active match scene both Junior and Senior, which all members are welcome to participate.

We also have an upcoming and exciting Junior Section which all juniors are urged to participate, it is an ideal platform for juniors from beginners to learn or improve their fishing skills. These are overseen by an Angling Trust Development Board Licensed Coach. All this is controlled by a dedicated Water Management Team, Committee and competent Bailiff presence to bring you the best sport possible.

CRICKET FIELD Withnell Fold PR6 8BA

Species: Tench, Perch, Roach, Rudd, Crucian Carp, F1 Carp & Carp

Recently stocked with great fishing, especially during the warmer month.. More roach are showing on this water some of which are 1-1.5lb, which seems to be improving year after year.

JUNIOR LODGE Withnell Fold PR6 8BA

Species: Roach, Perch, Pike, Carp, Bream, Tench, F1 Carp

Recently Stocked this is a popular carp water and productive coarse fishery... **N.B.** Close season applies to the Croft Lodge and the River Darwen from 15th March to 15th June. (Inclusive)

N.B. No keep nets during the above closed season 'between' 15th March to 15th June. (On all Waters)(Inclusive)

RUNSHAW POOL Euxton PR7 6FY

Species: Perch, Tench, Roach, Crucian Carp, Bream and Rudd.

Producing some nice bags of fish..

ROACH BRIDGE Samlesbury PR5 0UA

Species: Roach, Bream, Carp, Eels, Tench, Perch, Crucian carp..

Some great fishing here with nice peaceful quiet surroundings, which make the long walk worth-while! Currently our most productive match water with plenty of Roach and Bream being caught. Also, a good head of carp in here ranging in size up to 28lb.

SHALE HOLES Brinscall PR6 8RG

Species: Roach, Bream, Crucian Carp, Carp, Perch, Tench, Rudd

There is excellent fishing on this water! Any method or bait seems to produce fish of all varieties on this productive little water.

Disabled pegs have been constructed which it is hoped will benefit anglers on this water.

CROFT LODGE Brinscall PR6 8QU

Species: Bream, Roach, Carp, Perch, Pike, Tench & Rudd.

The water is fishing really well for carp, as well as huge catches of bream and silverfish being a regular occurrence. (Please be aware that a Closed Season still operates on this water).

RIVER DARWEN at Samlesbury. PR5 0RN

species: Chub, Brown Trout, Dace, Roach, Carp, Rainbow Trout

A lovely stretch of river, with peaceful surroundings and excellent access. A nice range of species, you never quite know what you are going to catch! (A closed season operates on these waters)

STRETCH OF LEEDS AND LIVERPOOL CANAL

Our length Leeds and Liverpool Canal runs from Bridge Number 87 Jacksons Bridge PR6 8BA to Bridge Number 92 Milfield Road Bridge .BB2 5JB. This is well-stocked section of the canal with a good head of Carp reputed to be up to 30lb.

You can also park at on the road by the boat yard, Finnington and Withnell Fold Bridges.

Your attention is drawn to the British Waterways code in the rulebook.

TOP LOCK POOLS PR6 8LP

A water for the carp lovers, there are restrictions on how you fish here, which are in our rule book. You will also need a key (cost is £4.00) Well stocked with carp and nothing else.

FARINGTON LODGES. PR26 6RA

There are 3 waters full of fish recently stocked from Carp, Bream, Roach, Rudd, Crucians, Tench and Pike with reports of other species. Go and give it a go, not the easiest water to fish but, can bring big surprises. Plenty of car parking here. There has been substantial improvements carried out on the water with funding from the Local Community, Parish, Borough & County Council.
