We have just been advised by the Angling Trust that **“further guidance will be issued by the government tomorrow 13th May that will require people to return to their home every night. This would technically preclude anglers from fishing overnight “**

The full statement is available for all to read on the news section of the Angling Trust website. As a result of this impending notification night fishing is currently not allowed

In addition the committee has decided that only members are allowed on our fisheries on account of the current safety guidelines. The guidelines have been posted on all our fisheries.

We have still not received an answer from the local borough councils so you cannot fish Shale Holes and Farington. At Roach Bridge you must still sign in and out
